## DIRECTIONS

### Floyd Room (for Breakfast)

20th floor of the Sloppy Floyd Building  
200 Piedmont Avenue  
Atlanta, Georgia 30334

#### Northbound on I-75/85:

- Exit at Central Avenue/Fulton St.
- Take a right at first light
- Take a left at next light, onto Capitol Avenue
- When Capitol Avenue turns into Piedmont, Sloppy Floyd Building is on right
- Floyd Room is on 20th floor of the West Tower

#### Southbound on I-75-85:

- Exit at Martin Luther King Jr., Drive/State Capitol
- Go straight through first light at Jesse Hill, Jr. Drive
- Sloppy Floyd Building is immediately on right
- Floyd Room is on 20th floor of the West Tower

## PARKING

Public parking in the following lots is open if space is available. Fees vary; generally, less than \$10 per day. *Please note, payment may be required upon entry.*

- [Pete-Hackney Parking Deck](#) (NOTE: The Pete-Hackney Parking Deck offers the easiest access to the Floyd Room where breakfast will be held.)
- [Steve Polk Plaza Parking](#)
- A **surface lot** located on the north side of Martin Luther King Jr. Drive, a block west of the Capitol
- [Underground Parking](#): A parking garage located on the north side of Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive, two blocks west of the Capitol

#### From the South:

- Take I-75/85 North to Exit 245 (Capitol Avenue)
- At the bottom of the exit ramp, continue straight through the stop sign
- At the first traffic light, turn left onto Hank Aaron Drive
- The Capitol will be approximately one mile down on the left

#### From the North:

- Take I-75/85 South to Exit 248A (Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive)
- Bear right onto Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive
- The Capitol will be on the left

#### From the East:

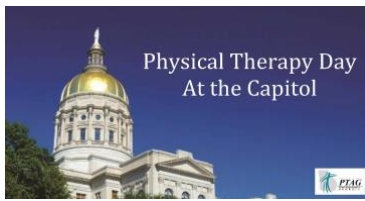
- Take I-20 West to Exit 58A (Capitol Avenue)
- Turn right on Capitol Avenue
- The Capitol will be approximately one mile down on the left

#### From the West:

- Take I-20 East to Exit 56B (Windsor St./Spring St./Stadium)
- At the third light, turn left onto Central Avenue
- Go to Mitchell Street and turn right
- The Capitol will be two blocks down on the left

## ACCESS SLOPPY FLOYD BUILDING FROM PETE HACKNEY PARKING DECK

Take the elevator or stairs to the 5th level. Proceed to the pedestrian bridge (crosses over Jesse Hill Jr. Dr into the Butler Parking Deck). In the Butler Parking Deck, take the elevator or stairs to the 3rd level (Bridge). Take the bridge into the Sloppy Floyd Building East Tower. Walk across to the West Tower. Security guard post will require a valid photo I.D. to enter.

## ACCESSIBILITY

- **Parking:** Spaces for visitors with disabilities are located on Mitchell Street. Vehicles may stop briefly at the loading zone to drop off passengers.
  - **Entrances:** Visitors in wheelchairs may enter the Capitol from the loading zone off Mitchell Street and from Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive via ramps which provide access to the first (ground) floor.
  - **Elevators:** The elevators are located on the east and west sides of the Capitol.
  - **Restrooms:** Wheelchair accessible restrooms are located on the first, third and fourth floors of the Capitol building. Facilities for ladies are located on the first floor, inside the Capitol Avenue entrance and on the third floor in room 342. Men's facilities can be found on the first floor and on the fourth floor adjacent to the House Gallery.
  - **Water Fountains:** Accessible water fountains can be found near the first-floor restrooms on the east side of the Capitol and inside the Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive entrance.
  - **Telephones:** Both a TDD and a Volume Control Telephone are located on the first floor of the Capitol in the restroom area.
  - **Galleries:** Wheelchair spaces are provided in the Senate and House galleries and most legislative committee meeting rooms are accessible.
  - **Capitol Grounds:** The paths leading to points of interest on the Capitol grounds are paved.

## DRESS CODE

The Capitol will be very crowded with legislators, staff, lobbyists and visitors. Please dress in business or business casual attire to maintain the professional atmosphere.

## SECURITY

In compliance with security regulations, all visitors must enter the Capitol through a metal detector; the X-ray machine must examine hand-carried items. No weapons, including pocketknives, are allowed in the Capitol. These items should be left in a vehicle because security is not able to hold these items. In addition, off-duty law enforcement officers will not be allowed to carry their weapons while they are inside the Capitol.
